**Subject: Clarification on Media Reports**

We refer to your emails dated March 12, 2018 and March 13, 2018. The Company is in receipt of the communication from Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) directing us to ground certain A320neo aircraft due to an ongoing Pratt & Whitney engine issue. The Company is in the process of implementing the directions of the DGCA.

Upon implementation of the DGCA's directive, the Company will have a total of nine (9) A320neo aircraft on the ground. This has resulted in cancellation of certain flights. Given that we have multiple flights to the same destination, we have proactively tried to re-accommodate all our affected passengers on other flights. All affected passengers have been given the option to either choose another flight at no additional cost or cancel their booking and get a full refund without any cancellation charges.
