

IndiGo commences additional flights from Delhi to Jaipur and Chandigarh

- Launches one flight each on the Delhi-Chandigarh-Delhi and Delhi-Jaipur-Delhi routes, on February 22, 2016
- Launches two additional flights on Delhi-Chandigarh-Delhi route on February 23, 2016

National, February 21, 2016: IndiGo, India's largest and fastest growing airline and favorite on-time performer, is adding an additional flight on its Delhi-Jaipur and Delhi-Chandigarh routes on February 22, 2016, due to the current unrest in parts of Haryana. In addition, the airline will also commence two additional flights from Delhi to Chandigarh on February 23, 2016, to enable those stranded due to the ongoing protests to travel between the two cities.

These supplementary flights will allow stranded passengers to travel between these cities, as rail transport is not fully operational and roads have been blocked by protestors.
