

## IndiGo adds Dehradun as its 40<sup>th</sup> destination; Announces new flights from Dehradun to Delhi, Mumbai, Bangalore and Hyderabad

- Effective March 01, 2016, IndiGo will launch three new daily non-stop flights on the Delhi – Dehradun route, and will further connect Mumbai, Bengaluru and Hyderabad as a one stop flight
- Effective March 01, 2016, IndiGo also introduces:
