



IndiGo launches Surat as its 56th destination

- Effective 16 August 2018, IndiGo to operate new flights from Surat; Surat will be connected with Delhi, Mumbai, Bangalore, Hyderabad, and Jaipur
- Additionally, IndiGo to operate three new routes including Jaipur- Varanasi, Jaipur Guwahati, and Mumbai- Bagdogra
- Bookings open with immediate effect with fares starting from INR 1999

National, June 29, 2018: After a successful launch of 7 domestic and 2 international destinations since January 2018, IndiGo has announced **Surat as its 56th destination**. The country's largest low-cost airline, IndiGo will now operate new flights to and from Surat connecting Delhi, Mumbai, Bangalore, Hyderabad, and Jaipur respectively.

To provide more enhanced connectivity across India, IndiGo will operate three new routes, including Jaipur-Varanasi, Jaipur Guwahati, and Mumbai-Bagdogra. All new services start in August 2018.
